Continued Recovery or Backward Slide?

Dr Seifried will review current economic conditions. He maintains that the Great Recession of 2007-09 is most likely over; however, the recovery from this recession, not unlike other recent recoveries, will have two components- GDP and Jobs. The GDP part of the recovery will be relatively rapid and robust, but the Job component of the recovery will be long and drawn out. However, the recovery is not etched in stone. He will investigate the possibility that the current recovery could be slowed or even reversed. He will also discuss the emergence of a disturbing new "bubble" in public debt and spending that could be as dangerous as the "private" bubbles that led to the great financial calamity of 2008-09.
